On May 1 - International Workers Day, Boston stood with 20+ cities in the US & Canada, rallying and marching to fight for a fair contract and living wages.

In Providence, RI - 170+ Local 26 hotel workers marched from several hotels until they reached the doors of the Omni Providence Hotel!









RESPECT US BY DOING THE RIGHT THING

Workers join unions so they can get fair wages, great benefits, & job security. In May, with the support of Boston City Council President Ruthzee Louijeune, City Councilor Ed Flynn, Rabbi Barbara Penzner, and Father Marc Fallon, workers at the Hyatt Regency Boston demanded a fair process to decide on unionization, free from harassment or intimidation.





Fidelity, via the Seaport Hotel, has pursued a union-busting strategy.

After the Union election, Fidelity gave wage increases and healthcare plan improvements only to non-union employees, while withholding those improvements from Banquets & Convention Services employees.

On May 21, Local 26 filed for a Union election on behalf of Hyatt Regency Hotel workers! When workers win the Union, they can have their cake and eat it too!
